

Statements required in notice if the proposed tax rate exceeds the no-new-revenue tax rate but does not exceed the voter-approval tax rate, as prescribed by Tax Code §§26.06(b-2).

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON TAX INCREASE

This notice only applies to a taxing unit other than a special taxing unit or municipality with a population of less than 30,000, regardless of whether it is a special taxing unit.

PROPOSED TAX RATE	\$.47290	per \$100
NO-NEW-REVENUE TAX RATE	\$.44685	per \$100
VOTER-APPROVAL TAX RATE	\$.49415	per \$100

The no-new-revenue tax rate is the tax rate for the 2024 (current tax year) tax year that will raise the same amount of property tax revenue for Tom Green County (name of taxing unit) from the same properties in both the 2023 (preceding tax year) tax year and the 2024 (current tax year) tax year.

The voter-approval tax rate is the highest tax rate that Tom Green County (name of taxing unit) may adopt without holding an election to seek voter approval of the rate.

The proposed tax rate is greater than the no-new-revenue tax rate. This means that Tom Green County (name of taxing unit) is proposing to increase property taxes for the 2024 (current tax year) tax year.

A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE PROPOSED TAX RATE WILL BE HELD ON August 22, 2024 @ 6:00 PM (date and time)
at Commissioners Courtroom, Judge Edd B and Francis Keyes Bldg, 113 W Beauregard, San Angelo Tx (meeting place).

The proposed tax rate is not greater than the voter-approval tax rate. As a result, Tom Green County (name of taxing unit) is not required to hold an election at which voters may accept or reject the proposed tax rate. However, you may express your support for or opposition to the proposed tax rate by contacting the members of the Commissioners Court (name of governing body) of Tom Green County (name of taxing unit) at their offices or by attending the public hearing mentioned above.
